Software License & Terms of Use

This Software License & Terms of Use ("Agreement") is between MM Custom Wiring ("Licensor," "we," "us") and the individual or business that installs or activates That's Your Business ("Customer," "you"). By installing, activating a trial of, or activating a license for That's Your Business (the "Software"), you agree to these terms.

1. License Grant

Licensor grants you a limited, non-exclusive, non-transferable license to install and use the Software on computers owned or controlled by your business, for your own internal business purposes. This license is for a single business entity; using one license across multiple, separate businesses is not permitted without our consent.

This license does not transfer ownership of the Software. All rights not expressly granted here are reserved by Licensor.

2. Trial Period

New installations include a free 30-day trial. No payment is required to trial the Software. At the end of the trial, continued use requires an active license key.

3. Fees and License Term

The current license fee is \$250/year. A license key is valid for one year from issuance. Before your key expires, we will provide a new key upon renewal payment; the Software will notify you in advance of an upcoming expiration.

If a license is not renewed, the Software will lock further use until a valid key is entered, but your data is never deleted, altered, or held hostage — it remains on your computer, untouched, and becomes accessible again immediately once a valid key is entered.

4. Your Data

All business data you enter into the Software (clients, jobs, estimates, invoices, financial records, and any documents you attach) is stored locally on your own computer. We do not have access to it, do not transmit it anywhere, and do not collect it. You are solely responsible for backing up your own data — we recommend regularly copying your That's Your Business data folder to a secondary location (external drive, cloud backup, etc.).

5. Restrictions

- You may not copy, modify, reverse-engineer, decompile, or create derivative works of the Software, except to the extent applicable law expressly permits.
- You may not resell, sublicense, rent, lease, or redistribute the Software or your license key to any other person or business.
- You may not attempt to bypass, disable, or circumvent the license activation or trial system.

6. Support and Updates

We may, at our discretion, provide updates, bug fixes, and reasonable email support. Support and updates are not guaranteed under this Agreement and may change or end at any time; if they do, the Software will continue to function under your existing license.

7. Disclaimer of Warranty

THE SOFTWARE IS PROVIDED "AS IS", WITHOUT WARRANTY OF ANY KIND, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, INCLUDING WITHOUT LIMITATION WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY, FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE, OR NON-INFRINGEMENT. Licensor does not warrant that the Software will be error-free or uninterrupted.

The Software's reports (profit & loss, job costing, budgets, and similar) are provided as calculation tools to assist your recordkeeping. They are not a substitute for a licensed accountant, bookkeeper, or tax professional, and Licensor is not responsible for how you use them for tax filing, financial decisions, or reporting to any third party.

8. Limitation of Liability

To the maximum extent permitted by law, Licensor's total liability arising from this Agreement or your use of the Software will not exceed the amount you paid for your license in the twelve (12) months before the claim arose. Licensor is not liable for indirect, incidental, special, or consequential damages, including lost profits or lost data, even if advised of the possibility.

9. Termination

You may stop using the Software at any time. We may terminate this license if you materially breach this Agreement (for example, redistributing your key) and fail to correct the breach within a reasonable time after notice. Termination does not entitle you to a refund of fees already paid, except as described below.

10. Refund Policy

If you're not satisfied, contact us within 30 days of your first paid license purchase for a full refund. Renewal payments are non-refundable once a new key has been issued.

11. Governing Law

This Agreement is governed by the laws of the State of Ohio, without regard to conflict-of-law principles.

12. Changes to This Agreement

We may update these terms from time to time for future versions of the Software. Continuing to use a version you've already licensed does not require you to accept later changes; a material change will be communicated before it applies to a renewal.
